



Squamish Poacher (Kambeitz)

Fish: Steelhead, Pacific Salmon

Hook	Mustad 3908, 3906B, size 2; Eagle Claw L1197G, size 2
Thread	Fluorescent Orange 6/0
Antennae	Sparse Orange Buck-tail
Eyes	Green Glass Beads Melted onto Monofilament, or you can just melt the monofilament ends to form rounded eyes.
Body	Fluorescent Orange Chenille, Figure Eight it Around Eyes to Build Up the Head Area
Hackle	Orange, Trimmed Short on Rear 1/2
Carapace	Fluorescent Orange Surveyor's Tape. Tie It In Over the Hook Eye and Bind it Down Over the Abdomen, Defining Each Segment With the Thread.
Rib	Fluorescent Orange Thread
Head/Tail	Florescent Red-Orange
