

# Chuck's Stripper Special



This is a Stripped Bass that Chuck Cameron caught on the Umpqua River just below Scottsdale, OR May 18, 1978. He caught this 30+ lb brute with his "Chuck's Stripper Special". He caught it at about 9:30 pm and had it in the boat about 10:20 pm. Chuck was using a 9' 6" rod with 9 weight floating line, with lead core fly line and 15lb tippet. Here is a picture of the original fly and the pattern for "Chuck's Stripper Special".



Hook: 4/0 Stainless  
Tail: 4" long Black Bear hair and 2 - 4" long Hoffman Grizzly Saddle Hackles  
Body: Large black chenille  
Collar: Hoffman Neck Grizzly Hackle, 5-6 wraps (sub. Natural Guinea)  
Eyes: Bead Chain Eyes
